1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus* upon the respondents to decide his representation dated 09.10.2024/ 11.10.2024 (Annexure P-1), which is pending decision before respondent no.-2-Deputy Commissioner, Jind.

2. The grievance which encapsulated through the present petition, is that the private respondent no.5, who is running a poultry farm, is disposing of the poultry waste near the vicinity of the house of the petitioner, which is creating a great nuisance for the petitioner.

3. This Court vide order dated 15.01.2025, had directed the State to have instructions as to what action has been taken on the representation (*supra*).

4. Learned State counsel today informs this Court that the Haryana State Pollution Control Board, has already made a refusal of consent to run the poultry farm, under the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, vide communication dated 16.12.2024. Even the waste from the vicinity of the petitioner has been cleared/cleaned.

5. In view of the above submissions, as made by learned State counsel, and the supervening events, no further direction is required to be passed by this Court in the instant petition. Therefore, the instant petition is **closed**. However, in case the grievance of the petitioner still survives, he is at liberty to revive the instant petition, by making an apt motion.

6. **Disposed of** accordingly.
