The Prayer in this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners which is under threat at the hands of the official of respondent nos.3 & 5 who are in connivance with private respondent nos.6 & 7.

The Counsel for the petitioners contend that the respondent no.3 is threatening the petitioners with false implication in a case, if they do not vacate or hand over the possession of the showroom to the private respondents. He thus contends that appropriate directions be issued to ensure the protection of the petitioners.

The Counsel for the State has filed status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Jaspinder Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police, Sub

Division Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, which is taken on record. He along with the counsel for respondent nos.6 & 7 contend that on an inquiry being conducted it was found to be a dispute of civil nature between a landlord and tenant. The statements of the parties were also recorded and nothing has come forth which could substantiate the allegations of the petitioner levelled in his representation dated 23.06.2025 (Annexure P-4).

I have heard Counsel for the parties.

In view of the aforesaid status report filed today, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail his remedies in accordance with law.
