3 On the resumed hearing today, on instructions from Pradeep Ahlawat, Additional Director, State Transport, Haryana, it has been informed by the learned State counsel that the respondents have already called the petitioners for personal hearing on 06.02.2025 and that they shall take a decision after considering the claim of the petitioners for appointment as Heavy Vehicle Drivers from the date candidates alleged to be lower in merit have been allowed to join within a period of 03 weeks thereafter.
