This application has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for placing on record the copy of the original affidavit of the complainant qua the compromise as Annexure P-4.

Allowed as prayed for and copy of the original affidavit of the complainant qua the compromise as Annexure P-4 is ordered to be taken on record.

Main case

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-'BNSS') for quashing of FIR No. 125 dated 05.08.2021 under Sections 434,447,506,34 IPC and Section 4 of Punjab Prevention of Damage to Public and Private Property Act added later on registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda District Bathinda, Punjab (Annexure P-2) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned State counsel states that no other FIR has been registered against the petitioners and they have no known criminal antecedents.

4. Ms. Priyanka Bhatia, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 and 3. She confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

5. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.

6. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 125 dated 05.08.2021 under Sections 434,447,506,34 IPC and Section 4 of Punjab Prevention of Damage to Public and Private Property Act added later on registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda District Bathinda, Punjab and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise shall stand quashed qua the petitioner subject to payment of Rs.5,000/- as costs to be paid to the High Court Legal Services Committee

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
