This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing order dated 22.07.2024 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals) Punjab.

1.1 A further prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct learned Financial Commissioner, Punjab to appoint the petitioner as Numberdar of Village Arayan Wala Kalan, Tehsil and District Faridkot.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not wish to press the instant writ petition on merits, however he submits that since the matter has been remanded to learned Collector for

deciding the matter afresh, time bound directions be issued for decision of the same.

3. Learned State counsel has not opposed to the aforesaid course being adopted.

4. In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as not pressed. However, it is directed that let the proceedings regarding appointment of *lambardar* of Village Arayan Wala Kalan, Tehsil and District Faridkot be concluded by learned Collector, Faridkot, within a period of six months from today.
