The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* setting aside the order of suspension dated 07.08.2009, Annexure P-1.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has been making representations to the respondents for the last so many years seeking withdrawal of the suspension order and/or regularising the period of suspension but the same has not been decided. Therefore, the petition should be treated as time barred.

3. This Court is not inclined to accept the submission, as making representations would not condone the delay of sixteen years in filing the petition; it cannot be considered sufficient explanation for the purpose.

4. Dismissed.
