1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0085 dated 05.06.2025, registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 351(2) of BNS 2023, at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.
2. Status report dated 03.09.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof, has been supplied to opposite counsel.
2. Vide order dated 01.08.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
4. Learned State counsel submits that during the course of investigation, the offence under Section 117(10) of BNS has also been added and the petitioner has joined investigation qua that offence also. At this stage, on oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the



aforementioned offence is ordered to be added in the headnote as well as prayer clause.

5. Learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 21.08.2025 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the nature of the allegations, pre-trial incarceration of the petitioner is also not required. As such, a case is made out for allowing the present petition. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 01.08.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
