1. The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioners seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the Over Time Allowance admissible to them from 01.04.2013 to 31.07.2014 and 01.01.2016 to 31.10.2016 by placing reliance on the decision of this Court dated 01.04.2013 passed in CWP-22516-2012 along with other connected matters and further upheld by the Hon'ble Apex Court vide judgment dated 31.01.2017 passed in Civil Appeal No.(s) 7391-7395-2013.

2 At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this juncture, the petitioners would be satisfied in case the respondent-Authorities are directed to look into the grievance espoused by the petitioners herein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

5 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.2-the Director General, Department of Transport, Government of Haryana, is directed to treat this petition as a representation by the petitioners and to take note of the same and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6 Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner is established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of four months.
