Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 has filed status report by way of affidavit dated 23.01.2024 of Sh. Jitender, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sohna, Gurugram and also a reply by way of affidavit dated 21.01.2025 of Sh. Hosyar Singh, HCS, Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), South Gurugram, which are taken on record. Copies thereof be supplied to the opposite side.

Registry to do the needful.

[2] Respondent No. 1-Hosyar Singh, HCS, SDO (Civil), South Gurugram, who is present in Court, submits that the eviction petition filed under Sections 5 & 7 of the Haryana Public Premises and Land (Eviction and Rent Recovery) Act, 1979, which is pending before him, shall be finally

adjudicated within a period of two months from today; thus, learned counsel for respondent No. 1 submits that no cause survives in the present petition.

[3] In view of the above undertaking, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed off** accordingly.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner(s) would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner(s) towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
