1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of The Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.161 dated 19.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 115(2), 126, 133, 351 of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (offence under Sections 304(2)/3 (5) of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 added later on) registered at Police Station Civil Lines Amritsar District Amritsar.
2. By virtue of order dated 11.12.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. However, learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submission made by counsel for the petitioner.
5. Learned State counsel, on instructions stated that the petitioner has affirmed the fact that he has joined the investigation and he is not required for

further investigation.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.12.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
