The instant contempt petition has been preferred under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, alleging disobedience of order dated 07.08.2024, passed in CWP-18832-2024 (Annexure P-1), vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to decide the petitioner's legal notice dated 29.04.2024 expeditiously in accordance with law.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from O/o Mr. Anish Yadav, DC, Hisar, submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, speaking order dated 26.09.2025 has been passed by the concerned authority. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that the petitioner shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law.
