Reply by way of affidavit of Director, Town and Country Planning Department, Haryana, Chandigarh, filed in the registry is taken on record.

2. The instant contempt petition has been preferred under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, alleging disobedience of order dated 01.05.2024, passed in CWP-7021-2024 (Annexure P-1), vide which the respondents were directed to pass a detailed order, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within four weeks from today, in accordance with law.

3. Learned State counsel, while referring to paragraph 3 of the reply, submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, speaking order dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed by the concerned authority.



4. In response, learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner shall, if so advised, avail all such other remedies as shall be admissible in law against the said order.

5. In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, no further orders are required to be passed and the present contempt petition is accordingly disposed of.
