HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned State counsel relies upon order dated 11.03.2025 passed by the Director General of Police, Punjab Chandigarh to submit that the petitioner has been granted the benefit of compassionate appointment and the necessary benefits have also been released in his favour in lieu thereof.

2. Learned State counsel further on instructions also assures that the petitioner shall be made to join within two weeks from today and shall also be provided the details of calculations regarding arrears paid to him within the said period.

3. In view of above, no cause survives in the instant petition. The same stands disposed of, however, in case the petitioner feels aggrieved of the aforementioned calculations, he shall be at liberty to move representation before the respondents within a period of two weeks from the date receiving the same, the same shall be considered and decided within four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by way of passing a speaking order, which shall be communicated to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter.

4. Rule stands discharged. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
