1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondents No.2 & 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of accused mentioned in FIR No.39, dated 14.05.2025, under Sections 126(2), 140(3), 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar Rural as private respondents are extending threats to the petitioner and his family members for their life and liberty. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.1 & 2 to constitute a Special Investigating Team to conduct a fair and impartial enquiry of above mentioned FIR as the police has not recorded the true version of the petitioner as he has specifically mentioned the name of Pawandeep Singh son of Mukhtiar Singh, Jograj Singh son of Manjit Singh and Ravinder Singh son of Lakhwinder Singh, who was the gang members of



Lovepreet Singh in the FIR but the police has not nominated them as accused under political pressure and even no action has been taken on the representation dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already filed his representation dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) before respondent No.2, but no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Karunesh Kaushal, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He submits that representation filed by the petitioner dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) would be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar District, Amritsar Rural to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by him.
