1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for intentionally and willfully disobeying order Annexure P-1 dated 28.08.2019 in CWP No.15384 of 2019.
3. Learned Addl. A.G. Haryana, states that operation of order Annexure P-1 dated 28.08.2019 in CWP No.15384 of 2019 has been stayed by Hon'ble the Division Bench in LPA No.462 of 2020 and in the circumstances, the contempt petition does not call for any orders and may be disposed of as such at this stage.
4. Faced with the aforementioned situation, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the Contempt Petition and the same may be disposed of as such at this stage while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition if the circumstances of

the case warrant on decision of application for vacation of stay in LPA No.462 of 2020 /decision of LPA No.462 of 2020.

5. The same is not opposed by learned Addl. A.G. Haryana.

6. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage with the liberty as prayed for.
