ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that wife of the petitioner had been allotted the plot in the year 1988 under the Local Displaced Person category. She had written to the respondents to permit her to deposit the balance amount and complete the other formalities but the respondent-Ludhiana Improvement Trust in their reply had stated that the file related to allotment is with the Vigilance Bureau in connection with an FIR registered against an employee of respondent-Ludhiana Improvement Trust. He also submits that a representation dated 21.03.2025 (Annexure P-14) has been sent to respondent No.2 in this regard.

2. Issue notice to the respondents.

3. Mr. Aftab Singh Khara, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the respondent No.2 and submits that further action could not be taken on the application of the wife of the petitioner as the allotment file is with the Vigilance Bureau.

4. Heard.

5. We deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the Director, Vigilance Bureau, Punjab to handover a photocopy of the file of allotment of the plot of petitioner to respondent No.2 within a period of one month from now. Thereafter, respondent No.2 shall consider the representation of the petitioner dated 21.03.2025 (Annexure P-14) and pass an order in accordance with law within a period of two months.
