1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 06.12.2022 passed in CWP-19181-2020.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Rajiv Rattan, Director, Higher Education Department, Haryana, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 06.12.2022 passed in CWP-19181-2020 has been complied with and speaking order dated 27.10.2023 has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
