VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (Oral):

1. Costs imposed vide order dated 08.04.2025 has since been deposited.
2. Affidavit of the Deputy Commissioner, Nuh filed in Court today, is taken on record. Copy furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned Counsel representing the State of Haryana submits that apart from the objections raised in the affidavit as regards the maintainability of the contempt petition, in so far as the grievance of the petitioner is concerned, paragraphs 14 and 15 clarify the current situation.
