1. On 29.09.2025, this Court passed the following order: -

“The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to release gratuity and pension as per last drawn pay.

The petitioner joined Punjab Police as Constable on 16.05.2002. He retired as Head Constable on 31.03.2024. He has been paid retiral benefits on the basis of last drawn pay, however, his pension and gratuity is not calculated as per last drawn pay. He was appointed prior to 01.01.2004, thus, is entitled to pension which still is not fixed. He has served representation dated 26.08.2025 upon the respondent.

Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, seeks a short accommodation to get instructions.

Adjourned to 08.10.2025.”

2. Learned State counsel submits that competent authority has resolved the grievance of the petitioner. The claim of the petitioner with respect to Old Pension Scheme was considered and papers were sent to

authorities in Madhya Pradesh because petitioner is residing in Madhya Pradesh. There were few objections from authorities in Madhya Pradesh. The Punjab State Authorities have removed the objections and re-sent the papers to Madhya Pradesh Authorities. Nothing is left to be done by Punjab State Authorities.

3. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.
