1. On 14.01.2025, the following order was passed:-

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that one of the appellants and some respondents have unfortunately expired. He prays for some time to bring on record the legal representatives of the said parties to the lis.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 25.03.2025.

In the meantime, records be also summoned.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the files of each connected case.

2. Thereafter, on 25.03.2025, the following order was passed:-

“On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the appellant(s) had submitted that one of the appellants and some respondents have unfortunately expired. Time had been sought to bring on record the legal representatives of the said parties. However, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 02.07.2025.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of the connected case.”

3. Today again, learned counsel for the appellant prays for some time to bring on record legal representatives of parties who have expired. Even the details of those who have expired, has not been furnished.

4. There is, therefore, no reason for this Court to defer the proceedings any further which are pending for preliminary hearing since 2022.

5. Dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the appellants to move a requisite application for revival of the appeal in case the LRs wish to pursue the same.
