The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of directions to the
respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case bearing FIR
No.115 dated 10.08.2024 under Section 420 of IPC registered at Police Station
Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1).

The learned State counsel has produced short reply dated
22.03.2025 by way of affidavit of Sh. Dilpreet Singh, IPS, Assistant
Superintendent of Police, Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur, on behalf of
respondents No.1 to 3-State in the Court today in compliance of order dated
19.02.2025 passed by this Court and the same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel submits that on the basis of
representation made by the petitioner on 28.01.2025 (Annexure P-3), the
veracity of his averments in the representation are being inquired into. Further,
the son of the petitioner has been nominated as an accused vide GD No.41

dated 22.10.2024 as the amount given by the complainant has been deposited in the account of Manjot Singh, son of the petitioner.

He further submits that the Investigating Agency is conducting the investigation in a fair and proper manner and the same would be taken to the logical conclusion and will be concluded within a period of two months, thereafter, final report Section 193 of BNSS (earlier Section 173 of Cr.P.C.) would be presented before the jurisdictional Court accordingly.

In view of the status report and the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, no further directions or orders are required to be passed in the present case and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
