1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to keep departmental proceedings in abeyance till the conclusion of criminal proceedings emanating out of FIR No.305 dated 25.09.2024, under Section 61 of The Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020) (Annexure P-1).

2. Mr. Aditya Yadav, Advocate for the petitioner submits that respondents may be directed not to proceed with departmental proceeding till the filing of police report under Section 193 of BNSS.

3. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. AG, Haryana concedes that this Court in similar cases has directed to keep the departmental proceedings in abeyance till the filing of police report.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid statement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent to keep departmental proceedings in abeyance till the date of filing of police report in aforesaid FIR.
