1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. with a prayer to direct the Trial Court to decide the complaint bearing No.COMI-135-2024, titled as "*Mohinder Kaur Vs. Navjeet Kaur etc.*", expeditiously, which is pending before the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a poor lady aged about 50 years and has been cheated by the respondents/accused. She had filed a complaint (Annexure P-1) before the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot. Now, the trial is pending before the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot and due to the long dates, proceedings before the Trial Court have been delayed.

3. At this stage, this Court does not deem it appropriate to issue notice to the respondents as no adverse order is being passed against the

respondents and the only prayer in the petition is with regard to the expeditious disposal of the trial pending before the Trial Court.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

5. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the Trial Court is directed to decide the trial expeditiously, in accordance with law.
