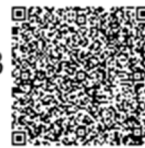

The present petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.17 dated 12.02.2025, under Section(s) 109, 115(2), 126(2), 351 (2), 191(3) and 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (hereafter to be referred as 'BNS 2023') registered at Police Station City-1, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

A perusal of the paper book shows that a specific averment has been made in para No.10 of the petition that the petitioner is not involved in any other FIR except the present FIR, however, State counsel submits that the petitioner is involved in three other FIRs.

Faced with above, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to file a fresh petition after making complete disclosure.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid.
