The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to get encroachment over public street made by respondent No.4 removed at the earliest.

1.1. A further prayer has been made by petitioner to decide the representation dated 27.12.2023 (Annexure P-5).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are some inadvertent errors in the instant writ petition, therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh one with better particulars.
