1. The present petition has been filed seeking enhancement of the maintenance amount of ₹12,000/- awarded vide order dated 04.08.2025 to the petitioner by the learned Principle Judge, Family Court, Narnaul.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not earning any income. However, upon a specific query regarding the petitioner's educational qualifications, counsel was unable to respond. It is not forthcoming how the petitioner has been maintaining herself over the years. Moreover, there is not even an *iota* of evidence or assertion that her expenses exceeds the maintenance amount of ₹12,000/- so awarded. Merely stating that; the maintenance should be enhanced; considering the income of the husband or that the amount awarded is on the lower side without any cogent proof; or that petitioner is unable to maintain herself, cannot be accepted as a valid ground for enhancement.

3. Furthermore, learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to

demonstrate any infirmity in the order passed by the Court below. Nonetheless, learned counsel is also unable to assist the Court with regard to the fact that whether the amount awarded by the learned Court below is being paid by the respondent to the petitioner or not, which clearly demonstrate that the counsel comes unprepared despite having signed the petition.

4. In light of the above, the Court is left with no choice but to dismiss the petition.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
