1. The present petition has been filed that the District Magistrate is not entertaining the application, which the petitioner has filed under Sections 22 and 23 of The Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 (hereinafter referred to as '2007 Act').

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per the Punjab Maintenance and Welfare of Parents Senior Citizens Rules, 2012, the Sub Divisional Magistrate is competent to receive the said application and decide the present petition and the petitioner is at liberty to file appropriate application before the Tribunal in case, he has any grievance to be raised under the 2007 Act and the same will be entertained.
