**MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-**

Through the instant petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS'), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 215 dated 08.11.2024 registered under Sections 262, 263, 221, 132, 61(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNS') at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

2. Vide order dated 07.02.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel filed status report dated 18.02.2025. The same is taken on record. She further, on instructions states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. Given the nature of allegations, no pre-trial incarceration of the petitioner is required. As such, without commenting on merits of case, it is



observed that a case for release of petitioner on bail is made out. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the order dated 07.02.2025 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the compliance of conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.

5. Since the main petition has been disposed of, pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
