1. By way of instant petition filed under Section 11 (6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short "the Act"), petitioner has approached this Court for appointment of an Arbitrator in terms of Memorandum of Understanding dated 25.01.2020, Annexure P-1.
2. Upon notice, respondent has appeared through Mr. Vijay Kadyan, Advocate, who has filed Power of Attorney as well as the resolution passed by the Board of Directors of the respondent-company, which are taken on record. Upon instructions received from Mr. Vijay Mehta, Authorized Representative of the respondent-company, he submits that respondent does not have any objection in case the prayer made in the petition is accepted.
3. Accordingly, petition is allowed. Sh. Raj Kumar, District & Sessions Judge (Retd.), resident of S-18/1A, DLF Phase-3, Gurugram,

5. Fee shall be paid in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Act, as amended.

6. Arbitrator is requested to complete the proceedings as per time limit specified under Section 29-A of the Act.

7. Liberty is granted to the parties to raise all claims, counter claims, defences, pleas etc. before the Arbitrator.

8. Needless to mention that all the questions arising between the parties in this matter shall remain open for determination in the arbitral proceedings and any observation made hereinabove will not be binding on the learned Arbitrator.

9. Copy of the order be sent to the appointed Arbitrator.

10. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
