1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-‘BNSS’) for quashing of GD No.21 dated 13.12.2023 under Sections 323, 341 and 506 IPC, arising out of FIR No.172, dated 12.12.2023 under Sections 452, 323 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 17.03.2025 (Annexure P-3).

2. This Court vide order dated 27.05.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amloh and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 12.06.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties. Status report filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and GD No.21 dated 13.12.2023 under Sections 323, 341 and 506 IPC, arising out of FIR No.172, dated 12.12.2023 under Sections 452, 323 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 17.03.2025 (Annexure P-3) are quashed qua the petitioner.
