2. On 19.03.2024, following order was passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Respondent No.2-Mr. Yashpal Wadhwa in the present case is stated to have died. Harsh Wadhwa, son of Mr. Yashpal Wadhwa has appeared in person and has produced the Death Certificate of Yashpal Wadhwa, which is taken on record. Harsh Wadhwa son of respondent No.2 appearing in person has submitted that he does not wish to pursue the RTI application filed by his father and has prayed for a short adjournment to move an appropriate application.
