1. The challenge is to the order passed by the learned Armed Forces Tribunal dated 30.03.2023.
2. Learned counsel submits that there was no occasion to round off the disability from 40% to 50%.
3. The issue is no more *res-integra* in view of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Bijender Singh v. Union of India and others, 2025 SSC OnLine SC 895**, which affirms the earlier judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Union of India and others vs. Ram Avtar 2014 SCC Online SC 1761**.
4. In view thereto, the writ petition is dismissed.
5. All pending misc. application(s) also stand disposed of.
