1. The present petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP-13469-2025 titled as 'Dinesh Yadav vs. State of Haryana and others', whereby it was directed as under:-

“4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 (competent authority), to look into the complaint/representation dated 11.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and take an appropriate action thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.”

2. Compliance report dated 13.09.2025, filed in Court by way of affidavit of Sh. Pradeep Dahiya, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Gurugram, is taken on record. A copy thereof, has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent refers to speaking order dated 12.09.2025 (Annexure R-1) to submit that in compliance of the order dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-1), speaking order (Annexure R-1)



has been duly passed in the matter, therefore, nothing survives in the present petition.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the above, the order dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) stands duly complied with and nothing survives in the present petition; and the same may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

6. In view of the facts noted above, no further direction is required to be passed; and the present petition is hereby **disposed of**, as having been rendered **infructuous**.
