**ASHWANI KUMAR MISHRA J. (ORAL)**

Learned Single Judge has dismissed the second review application filed by the writ petitioners after noticing the fact that the writ petition was allowed on 29.07.2015 and the review has been filed with inordinate delay of 2150 days.

2. Learned Single Judge has also noticed that the first review application was rejected on 07.05.2024.

3. Facts as has been noticed by the learned Single Judge in para 1 and 2 of the impugned judgment reads as under:-

*“1. Present petition has been filed for review of order dated 01.02.2019 passed by this Court, whereby the writ petition was allowed and the order impugned therein dated 29.07.2015 was quashed. The present petition has been filed*

*with an inordinate delay of 2150 days. Admittedly, the first review petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 07.05.2024 and the present is the second review petition filed for review of order dated 01.02.2019, which is not maintainable. Moreover, there is no substantial explanation for an inordinate delay of 2150 days.*

*2. This Court does not find any ground to entertain present petition which is barred by an inordinate unexplained delay of 2150 days and the same is therefore, dismissed.”*

4. We do not find any cogent ground to have been placed by the appellant in support of its prayer for condonation of delay. The filing of the second review petition, in such circumstances, was wholly barred apart from it being filed with inordinate delay.

5. Accordingly, the appeal stands dismissed.

6. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
