In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the impugned result dated 05.01.2021 (Annexure P-5) as well as impugned notice dated 06.01.2021 (Annexure P-6) for shortlisting of candidates for interview whereby the qualifying marks for Urdu language Section was wrongly fixed as 40% instead of 35%.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that similar issue has already been decided by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in *CWP No.1792 of 2021* titled as *Jagjeet Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another*, which was dismissed vide order dated 25.02.2021.
