1. The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of the private respondents and to further restrain them from harassing the petitioners or interfering in their peaceful life.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for protection of their life and liberty, petitioners have moved representation dated 30.05.2025 (Annexure P-7), however, no action has been taken thereon till date. He submits that at this stage, petitioners would be satisfied, if the said representation is considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed off only with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot, that if

any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioners.
