

**IOIN-CWP-31571-2024 in CWP-31571-2024****RANDEEP DALAL  
VS  
UNION OF INDIA AND OTHERS**

Registry has put up this matter in pursuance of the order dated 22.11.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, wherein the Superintendent of Police, Karnal was directed to hold an enquiry as the Haryana Police has failed to inform the Passport Authorities, with respect to the pending FIRs against the petitioner-Randeep Dalal. A further direction was issued to submit the report to the Registrar of this Court, within one month.

In compliance of the said order dated 22.11.2024, the compliance report dated 19.12.2024 has been filed by way of an affidavit of Sh. Ganga Ram Punia, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Karnal. The relevant extract of which reads as under:

“ - x - x - x

*2. That it is humbly submitted that in compliance of order dated 22.11.2024 passed by the Hon'ble High Court, a preliminary enquiry was assigned to DSP HQ Karnal who conducted the preliminary enquiry in this matter and submitted report before the deponent. As per enquiry report of enquiry officer three cases bearing FIR No. 91 dated 13.05.2005 U/s 323, 324, 326/34 IPC PS Madhuban, FIR No.34 dated 13.08.2019 U/s 309, 34, 509 PS Sector 32-33 Karnal and FIR No.30 dated 11.08.2019 U/s 354A, 506, 419 IPC PS City Karnal were found to be registered against the petitioner Randeep Dalal. However, during verification the detail of FIR No.91/2005 PS Indri and FIR No.30/2019 PS Sector 32-33 Karnal were not mentioned by the concerned*

*police officials. Further, certain lapses on the part of MHC, computer operator and additional SHO Police Station Madhuban were found by the enquiry officer.*

*3. That it is humbly submitted that on the basis of report of enquiry officer show cause notice has been issued to SI Lachman No.856/KNL, HC Ravinder Kumar No.937/KNL and C-1/Ct Devraj No.994/KNL vide this office No.957-59/ST dated 19.12.2024. After their reply to the aforesaid notice is received, appropriate disciplinary action will be initiated against them as per the provisions of Punjab Police Rules, 1934 (as applicable in Haryana).”*

A perusal of the above extracted report shows that the certain lapses on the part of MHC, Computer Operator and Additional SHO of Police Station Madhuban, were found by the Enquiry Officer and on that basis show cause notices have been issued to Sub Inspector Lachman No.856/KNL, HC Ravinder Kumar No.937/KNL and C-1/Ct. Devraj No.994/KNL. It is mentioned that appropriate disciplinary action has already been initiated against them as per the provisions of Punjab Police Rules, 1934 (as applicable in Haryana).

Keeping in view the above, the compliance report is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions and a further direction is issued to the Superintendent of Police, Karnal, to submit the final action taken against the aforesaid officials before the Registrar of this Court, within a period of three months from today.
