VINOD S.BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral) :

Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to pay the revised pension of deceased-Jeet Ram, father of the present petitioner who retired on 31.05.2006 from the respondent No.2- Department.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-4) but the respondents have not taken any action upon the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that at this juncture, he confines his prayer to the limited extent of directing respondent No.2- The Controller, Printing & Stationery Department, Haryana to decide the claim raised by the petitioner as espoused in detail in the present writ petition by treating the same as a representation.

Learned State Counsel does not have any objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2 to consider and claim raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition by treating the same as a representation by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the above-said claim raised, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of two months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
