1. This is an incomplete case which is pending before this Court since 2024, and has been listed before this Court by the registry for passing appropriate orders. In fact, there is a general direction for listing all those cases, which have neither been pursued, nor the requisite corrections and the defects as pointed out by the registry, have been removed.

2. Considering the aspect that the main petition was filed for quashing of FIR No.83, dated 22.06.2021, under Sections 341, 324, 506, 34 of IPC (Section 307 of IPC added later on), registered at P.S. Amluh, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-6), and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 17.07.2024 (Annexure P-7), and no one has turned up to meet out the objections/deficiencies, which were pointed out by the Registry, same requires to be disposed of in accordance with law.

3. Thus, the present petition is hereby dismissed, same being neither valid nor prosecuted.
