**SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)**

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 07.10.2023, passed by this Court in in RSA-3140-2023.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents contends that in compliance of order dated 07.10.2023, short reply by way of an affidavit of Ms. Shweta Suhag, HCS, Estate Officer, HSVP, Rohtak, dated 10.03.2025 has been filed along with Annexure R-1 and R-2, which is attached with the present petition. This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. Para 4 of the affidavit dated 10.03.2025, is reproduced as under:-

*“That the site in question was visited accordingly and report was submitted before this Hon’ble Court on 17.10.2023 stating that there is a 02 Karam revenue rasta*



*abutting the property i.e. 29//25 and the said revenue rasta is to be used by the petitioner accordingly. It is pertinent to mention herein that the petitioner in the present petition has also filed the objections in the RSA No.3140 of 2023 against the report filed by the respondents and the matter is now pending adjudication for 13.05.2025.”*

4. A perusal of above shows that order dated 07.10.2023, passed by this Court in RSA-3140-2023, has been complied with.

5. In view of the above, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.
