SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 09.05.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-9951-2023.

2. The relevant portion of order dated 09.05.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-9951-2023, is reproduced as under:-

“5. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.5 to consider the representation dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law and in case, respondent No.5 is of the opinion that action is required to be taken on the basis of plea raised by the petitioner, then appropriate action in accordance with law be taken as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months



from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order. The same would be done after providing the due opportunity of hearing to the persons against whom action is sought to be taken.”

3. Learned State counsel contends that in compliance of order dated 09.05.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-9951-2023, a speaking order dated 04.09.2025 is passed, which is taken on record. A copy of speaking order dated 04.09.2025 is supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner as well.

4. A perusal of the above shows that order dated 09.05.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-9951-2023, has been complied with by passing speaking order dated 04.09.2025. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.

6. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
