1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.747 dated 28.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 115, 126, 190, 191(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Sections 74, 75, 115(2) & 126(2) of BNS, 2023 were added later on) at Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sh.Rajesh Kumar Mohan, IPS, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Hisar, on behalf of the respondent-State, has been filed in the Registry which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order dated 29.11.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.
