1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 142 dated 09.08.2023, under Sections 21(c), 25, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amrtisar.

2. During the course of hearing of the bail petition, it is informed that petitioner is accused in two other cases punishable under the provisions of the NDPS Act and those two cases were registered prior to the registration of present case.

In the instant case, as per the case of the prosecution, there is a recovery of 12.400 kgs of heroin from the car, which was being driven by the petitioner. Recovery of such a huge quantity of contraband

cannot be taken lightly, especially when such contraband is the subject matter under NDPS Act.

3. Not only this, petitioner had approached earlier also to this Court for seeking bail by way of CRM-M-9082-2025 and said petition was disposed of having been withdrawn, by directing trial Court to expedite the trial proceedings vide order dated 24.02.2025 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

In view of the aforementioned reasons, this Court is not inclined to entertain the petition for the same relief i.e of bail, hence, present petition is hereby dismissed.
