**KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)**

1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus*, upon the respondents, to release arrears of wages, allowance, gratuity etc. along with interest @18% per annum, on the delayed payment, in view of the judgment of Full Bench of this Court.

2. This Court, vide order dated 24.09.2025, has passed the hereinafter extracted order, upon the instant writ petition:-

*“Learned State counsel expresses his inability to provide any instructions, as sought by this Court vide order dated 04.09.2025, on the ground that there is no response from the office of Assistant Labour Commissioner, Rewari, despite repeated attempts to contact the said officer.*

*It appears that the officers/officials of the Haryana Government are not treating the office of the Advocate General, Haryana, with due seriousness, which generally causes embarrassment to the Law Officers, before this Court.*



*In view of the above, this Court is left with no other option, except to direct the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Rewari, to cause his/her personal appearance before this Court on the next date of hearing positively, to provide requisite information, which is necessary for disposal of the instant petition.*

*Adjourned to 30.09.2025.*

*To be shown in the urgent list.*

*It is made clear that no further request for an adjournment shall be entertained on the next date of hearing, on behalf of either of the parties.*

*Since abovesaid officer is not responding to the communications of the office of the Advocate General, Haryana, therefore, the Registry of this Court is directed to forthwith, communicate this order, to the officer concerned, for its compliance.”*

3. In deference to the directions (supra), Mr. Pawan Sharma, Assistant Labour Commissioner, Rewari, has caused appearance today, before this Court, and submits that he will take apt action on the letter dated 30.01.2023 (Annexure P-11), within a period of seven working days, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. In view of the undertaking given by the officer concerned, no further order is required to be passed in the instant writ petition, and the same is hereby **closed**.

5. This Court is sanguine that Assistant Labour Commissioner, Rewari, shall abide by the undertaking given before this Court.

6. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**.
