1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in case FIR No.20 dated 27.01.2025, under Sections 115(2), 118(1) 126(2), 351(2), 191(3), 190 and 304(b) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Patiala.
2. Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division City-1, District Patiala in Court which is taken on record.
3. It is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner had provided sword to co-accused Jaskaran Singh who had caused injuries on the head of the complainant. However, the petitioner has neither given any injury which is amounting to an injury on the head nor given any sharp edged injury on the

head of the complainant. However, after examining the police report and the medical evidence, it has come to light that the petitioner has given injuries to the injured with a danda although the injuries are blunt. Moreover, the petitioner has actively participated in the occurrence. The petitioner is also stated to be involved in four more FIRs i.e. (i) FIR No.194 dated 04.06.2021, under Section 8 of the POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala; (ii) FIR No.76 dated 15.06.2023, under Sections 341, 324, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala; (iii) FIR No.91 dated 11.08.2023, under Sections 307, 326, 325, 323, 336, 341, 279, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala; and (iv) FIR No.107 dated 29.07.2023, under Sections 324, 341, 148, 149, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala.

4. In light of the above, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the petition stands dismissed.

5. However, if the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and shall move an application for grant of regular bail which shall be considered by the trial Court expeditiously.
