The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 19.3.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 7523 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above and without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without even going into the merits of the claim raised by the petitioner/Contractor, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondent No. 2 i.e. the Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitation Division, Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of a representation dated 23.8.2018 (Annexure P-7) expeditiously and in any case within a period of eight weeks from the date

of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that in case any amount is due to the petitioner, the same would be released without any further delay.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not examined the claim of the petitioner on merits.”

As per order dated 19.3.2019, the respondents had to take a decision on the representation of the petitioner expeditiously and in any case within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order.

Though the time period has elapsed, at this stage, still another opportunity is provided to the respondents to do the needful within eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case of failure, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and the revival would be at the cost and responsibility of the defaulting official.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
