Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 30.7.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-14926-2021 titled as “Dalbir Singh Teji vs. State of Punjab and others”, vide which the petition was disposed of with a direction “.....to open the sealed cover keeping in view the recommendation of the DPC Dated 08.1.2018 and take appropriate action in accordance with law as required keeping in view the recommendation made therein. Let the order be complied with within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.”



At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 30.7.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court, Speaking Order dated 02.5.2025 has been passed by the competent authority.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 02.5.2025 by the competent authority; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 02.5.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner(s). Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further. However, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that in case the petitioner is aggrieved of the said order dated 02.5.2025 he may be permitted to assail the same in accordance with law.

Dismissed as not pressed.

The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid Speaking Order dated 02.5.2025 as per law.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
