The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.15 dated 04.02.2015 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 498-A IPC, registered at Women Police Station, Ludhiana which was lodged by respondent No.2-wife after 08 years of marriage and about 05 months of moving similar complaint before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana which remained pending till 09.07.2015 when the same was dismissed under Section 203 of Cr.P.C. however, same fact has been concealed by respondent No.2 while filing a complaint on the basis of which the present FIR was lodged and further FIR has been the counter blast of the complaint lodged by the petitioner against his wife on 29.05.2014.
2. Petitioner, who has appeared in person, has produced a copy of the judgment dated 05.03.2025 passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana whereby the petitioner has been acquitted. He

submits that in view of the said development, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
