Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 27.9.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector which was duly submitted on affidavit before this Court on 22.3.2017 in COCP No.125 of 2014 titled as "Raj Pal and others vs. Mohamad Shayin" and for punishing respondent No.1 for not ensuring the compliance of the undertaking given before the Court and respondents No.2 to 4 have failed to fulfil their duties by way of not complying with the specific undertaking given by respondent No.1.



In pursuance of order dated 25.4.2023 passed by this Court, learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 has already filed the reply dated 21.8.2023 by way of affidavit of Anindita Mitra, IAS, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh in the Registry, which is annexed with the file. The said Reply is ordered to be taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 submits that necessary compliance has been made; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the said fact and admits that as per reply dated 21.8.2023 the compliance has been made.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
