1. Petitioner in the FIR captioned above, has come before this Court under Section 483 BNSS, 2023 seeking regular bail.

2. At the outset, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh after a period of one year if trial is not concluded. He submits that he would be satisfied if he is given permission to file the bail application before the trial court, if the trial is not concluded within a period of one year.

3. Given the submission of the counsel for the petitioner present petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.

Trial court is directed to expedite the trial. It is clarified that in case,

the trial is not concluded within one year, in that case, petitioner shall be at liberty to file application for bail before the trial Court which shall consider the bail petition of petitioner on prolonged incarceration as well as on merits without being influenced by the earlier orders of rejection passed by trial court or by this Court. However, the time for which the trial is delayed because of any of the accused including the petitioner shall not be counted while counting the period of one year as given in the liberty by this Court.

4. All pending applications, if any stand disposed of.
